This petition coming on 12.08.2026 for final hearing before me in the presence of Tr.P.Srinivasan,M.A.,B.L., learned counsel for Petitioner/Accused, the Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade II appeared for Respondent/complainant upon hearing both side and upon perusal of the records, this court delivers the following.

ORDER

1. This bail application filed by the Petitioner/Accused in Cr.No.15/2026 U/s 66(D) IT Act, 318(4) BNS Act. The accused Person was remanded to Judicial Custody on 07.08.2026

2.The learned counsel for Petitioner/Accused submits that, the Petitioner/Accused is an innocent person, false case has been foisted against the petitioner. The accused in preferred to furnish substantial sureties. Hence he prays for Bail.

3. The respondent police has raised a serious objection that case is still under investigation. Further amount of Rs.48,500/- have been received to the petitioners

bank account which is alleged to be an amount transferred from layer one account of cyber fraud. Hence, the prosecution strongly opposed to grant bail at this stage.

4. This court heard the rival submissions and perused the material records. The accused person is in judicial custody from 07.08.2026 to till date. The accused person is in judicial custody nearly 06 days. The material records shows that on 11.06.2026 Rs.48,500/-and on 15.06.2026 Rs.49,000/- has been credited to the petitioners account from the same person. The co-accused was already remanded to the judicial custody. Moreover, investigation is still at nascent stage. If the accused is released on bail at this stage it would affect the effective investigation and considering the alleged scam which is serious in nature, this court is not inclined to enlarge the accused on bail and thus this petition is dismissed.
