

Rajpal Singh v. State of Haryana

Applicant in person with Sh. Ashutosh Saroha, Advocate.

Heard on application for releasing of 186 wheat bags on superdari, filed by the applicant through counsel. The applicant is placed on record copy of license which establish that Rajpal is license holder and proprietor of M/s Dariyav Singh Company.

No tenable reason is given by the SHO Police-station Kharkhoda for not releasing the wheat bags on superdari.

Arguments heard. The trial of the case will take long time and no useful purpose will be served by retaining the wheat bags in the police custody. **(Reliance can be placed upon Sunderbhai Ambalal Desai Vs. State of Gujarat, 2003(1) Recent Criminal Reports, 380).**

Hence in view of above discussion, without commenting on the merits of the case, wheat without plastic bags be released to the applicant on his furnishing indemnity bonds in the sum of Rs. 2.50 Lac with one surety in the like amount to the **satisfaction of the SHO/In-charge of police station/Police Post concerned against proper receipt and verification.**

The SHO is directed to prepare a detailed panchnama of the bags along-with photographs before its release.

Accordingly, application stands disposed of. Copy of this order be forwarded to concerned SHO/In-charge of police station/Police Post for compliance. Papers be tagged with FIR.
