Today is fixed for ex parte hearing of the suit.

Petitioner/wife is present along with her Ld. Lawyer.

The affidavit in chief filed by the petitioner Smt. Chandra Biswas and her mother Smt. Rekha Biswas are tendered in open Court and they are examined as PW1 & PW2 respectively and discharged. PW1 proved the Marriage Registration Certificate as Ext.-1.

On the prayer of petitioner evidence is closed.

Record is taken up for passing order.

This is a case u/s.27 of the Special Marriage Act,1954.

The case of the petitioner in brief, is that, her marriage with the respondent was registered on 21.09.2023 as per Special Marriage Act and on the same date the said marriage was socially solemnized. After the said marriage she started residing with the respondent as husband and wife and their marriage was duly consummated. In the said wedlock no child was born. Since the very inception of her stepping into her marital life the petitioner was subjected to inhuman physical and mental torture by the respondent and his other family members. They started creating pressure to bring more dowry from her paternal home. The respondent was not provided with proper food and medicine. The respondent is a drunkard person and every night he used to return home in drunken state and tortured the petitioner. On 15.11.2023 the petitioner was driven out from her matrimonial home. Finding no other alternative petitioner filed the instant suit praying for decree of divorce on the grounds stated above.

The respondent though appeared in this case but ultimately did not contest this case for which this Court fixed the matter for ex parte hearing.

To substantiate her contention, the petitioner adduced evidence as PW1 and her mother adduced as PW2 and the marriage Registration Certificate has been marked as Ext.-1.

From the unchallenged and corroborated testimony of PW1 and PW2 it appears that she had successfully proved her case and entitled to get the decree of divorce.

Hence, it is

O R D E R E D

that the present **Matrimonial Suit No. 451 of 2025** u/s.27 of Special Marriage Act, 1954 be and the same is decreed *ex parte* in favour of the petitioner/wife namely **Smt. Chandra Biswas** against the respondent/husband, namely, **Sri Anup Sen** but without any order of costs.

The marriage between the parties, namely, **Smt. Chandra Biswas** and **Sri Anup Sen** which was solemnized and registered on 21.09.2023 according to Special Marriage Act is hereby dissolved from the date of this order.

Draw the decree accordingly.

Let a copy of this order be supplied to the petitioner free of cost.
