**MAHIPAL SHARMA Vs. STATE**

Present : Sh. Pawan Sharma, Counsel for the petitioner along with petitioner, **physically**.

Ms. Kaushalya Sharma, claims to be wife of Sh. Chandrapal Sharma, **physically**.

She submitted that she may be provided the copy of the petition so that she may also file reply of the present petition filed under Section 276 of Indian Succession Act.

Sh. Depender Kumar, Kanoongo, Office of SDM, Vasant Vihar, **physically**.

Kanoongo filed reply stating that occupant of the property bearing house no.60, Vasant Goan, New Delhi did not cooperate with the Revenue Staff , Tehsil Vasant Vihar, therefore, valuation of property in question could not be carried out.
