Present: Mr. Vineet Taneja, Advocate for the plaintiff through Cisco Webex Meetings.

Steps not taken on behalf of the plaintiff for getting issued the summons against the defendants.

An application under Order VI Rule 17 read with section 151 of CPC is made on behalf of the plaintiff for amending the plaint. Heard. It is submitted by counsel for the plaintiff that inadvertently the addresses of the defendants in the plaint have been mentioned as “Mojor Asha Ram Tyagi Road, Modinagar, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh-201204” instead of “Major Asha Ram Tyagi Road, Modinagar, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh-201204”, therefore, to correct the addresses of the defendants the plaintiff want to amend the plaint.

After hearing counsel for the plaintiff and going through the material on record the application under Order VI Rule 17 read with section 151 of CPC made on behalf of the plaintiff for amending the plaint is allowed. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

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At the request of counsel for the plaintiff, on filing PF and postal expenses etc. within seven days by the plaintiff issue fresh summons against the defendant, to be served through registered post acknowledgment due returnable on 03.11.2025.

At the request of counsel for the plaintiff, in view of the provisions of Order V Rule 9A of CPC one set of summons be also given dasti to the plaintiff for service upon the defendants on filing of additional PF.
