

Heard Sri.SMK Advocate for plaintiff on IA.II.

Perused the plaint averments, documents and affidavit filed in support of IA.No.II.

IA.No.I is filed U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC claiming an order of temporary injunction.

By considering the materials on record, at this stage, I found an arguable case to pass an interim order on IA.No.II.

In view of the urgency and apprehension shown by plaintiff, I feel that an exparte interim order has to be passed on IA.No.II by dispensing with the notice to the defendants. Hence, I proceed to pass the following interim order on IA.No.II.

ORDER

Temporary injunction is granted restraining defendants from making the renewal of the plaintiff association by penalizing or otherwise as per the notification of the Karnataka Government Dtd: 19.05.2022 and not to take any further actions in regard to the above notification of the Karnataka Government till disposal of the suit.

This order shall be in force till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff to comply order 39 Rule 3 of CPC.

After due compliance, issue emergent notice of IA.I, TI order and suit summons to the defendants.
