Present: Ld. Counsel for the complainant.
Ld. Counsel for accused along with accused.

Accused is directed to file vakaltnama and bail bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety in the like amount on or before the NDOH.

Notice of accusation u/s 251 Cr.P.C has been served upon the accused to which the accused pleaded not guilty and claimed trial. Plea of defence of the accused has also been recorded. Ld. Counsel for the accused has orally submitted u/s 145(2) NI Act.

In view of plea of defence of accused, probable defence has been raised. Therefore, accused is granted one opportunity to cross examine complainant on next date of hearing.

In these circumstances, in view of the second proviso to section 143 (1) of the NI Act, instead of being tried summarily, this case shall now be heard as a summons trial case.

The cheques in question and returning memo for the same is admitted by the accused. Therefore, the witness at serial no. 2, 3 and 4 are hereby dropped from the list of witnesses.

Both the parties are directed to appear physically before the court on NDOH for cross examination of complainant.

Accused submits that he is willing to settle the matter.

At request of both the parties, matter is referred to mediation **for 08.05.2024 at 02:00 p.m** and before the Court on 28.11.2024.

At request of both the parties let the matter be put up for CE **on 28.11.2024.**
