Today is fixed for delivery of judgment.

The accused persons is/are present before the court by filing *hazira*.

The Ld. Advocate on his/their behalf is also present.

On the other hand, complainant and the Ld. advocate on his behalf is also present.

It is now 3 p.m.

Now the judgment is ready.

Accordingly, the judgment is pronounced in open court.

Operative part of the judgement reads as-

Hence it is,

O R D E R E D

That the convict namely, Shri Subhas Paul, S/O Lt. Tarapada Paul of Bagna, P.O. and P.S. Gaighata, Dist. North 24 Parganas is hereby ***found guilty*** in this case for committing offence punishable under Sec. 138 of the *Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881*. Accordingly, he is ***convicted*** under Sec. 255(2) of the *Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973*. He is hereby sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for the period of ***3 months (Three months)*** and also directed to pay a fine of ***Rs. 09,52,940/- (Rupees Nine Lakh, Fifty-Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Forty only)*** in default ***simple imprisonment for 3 months more***.

40. The complainant Shri Parimal Kr. Roy will be entitled to get the said amount of Rs. 09,52,940/- (Rupees Nine Lakh, Fifty-Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Forty only) if be realised from the convict as per the provisions of Sec. 357(1)(b) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as a compensation.

41. The concerned surety/sureties is/are discharged from his/her/their respective bail bond/bonds and liability/liabilities and the surety/sureties' amount be adjusted.

42. The convict is asked by the court whether he prefer any appeal before the appellate court through DLSA and whether he require copy of necessary documents for which the convict stated before the court that he prefers an appeal before the upper court.

43. The case is accordingly disposed of in contested form.

44. Let, a copy of this judgment be given free of cost to the convict at once.

45. Note in the Germane Register/Trial Register.

46. Let the soft copy of this judgment be uploaded in the CIS within 48 hours from this day as per Rule 186A of the Cr. R. O. of the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta.

47. The victim/victims in the case is/are also in liberty to prefer an appeal before the Ld. Appellate Court as per provision of Sec. 372 of the Cr. P. C. against the order of conviction of the accused person/persons. If necessary, victim/victims can also avail the free legal aid/assistance through the legal services authorities concerned to prefer and prosecute such appeal.

48. Let, a copy of this judgment be sent to DLSA, North 24 Parganas at Barasat and D. M. North 24 Parganas at Barasat at once in compliance with the direction of the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta vide Hon'ble Court's order dated 29.03.2022 in c/w CRA 266 of 2020 with CRAN 1 of 2020.
