

to humiliate this Court and raise allegation against this Court that this Court is releasing the accused persons in lieu of money.

The Id. Advocates of Basirhat Court have a long history of boycotting the Courts whenever their interests were hampered. They have boycotted the Courts of Ld. Additional District and Session Judge FTC 1st Court Shri Pradip Adhikary, Ld. ADJ FTC 3rd Court Smt. Arati Sharma, Ld. ADJ Basirhat Court Smt. Bharati Bhattacharya, Ld. Civil Judge 2nd Court (Jr. Div.) Md. Ruknuddin, Ld. ACJM Shri P.K Sinha 2, Ld. Civil Judge (Sr. Div.) Shri Ratan Gupta, Ld. Additional District Judge Shri Subol Khamari, Ld. ACJM Shri Uday Rana, Ld. JM 1st Court Shri Abhishek Minj, Ld. JM 2nd Additional Court Shri Indranil Karmakar. It is learnt that on the basis of Reference made by the Ld. ADJ FTC 3 Basirhat Smt. Arti Sharma previously also Contempt proceeding was started against Ld. Advocates of Criminal Court Bar Association of Basirhat Court including the Ld. advocates **Asif Alam and Biswajit Roy. Mr. Asif Alam** openly declared that they do not care any such Contempt Proceeding.

The Id. Advocates of Basirhat Criminal Court Bar Association are not allowing the litigants to come before this Court on and from 02.12.24 and the witnesses (Victim Girl) was also returned from the Court in Special POCSO Case No. 51 of 19. In CRM (NDPS) No. 161 of 2024 the Hon'ble Court held that Resolution of a Bar Association not to attend proceedings shall not stand in the way of examination of witness. In the event the Id. Counsels of the proceedings decline to participate and examine the witnesses on the excuse of the Bar the Trial Court concerned shall refer the matter to the High Court for initiating Criminal Contempt against the Id. Counsel concerned as well as the President and Secretary of the Bar Association which has taken such Resolution interfering the smooth administration of Justice.

In such facts and circumstances a reference under section 15(2) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is being made to the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta to initiate proceedings of Criminal
