J U D G E M E N T

This is a petition u/s 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

Both the petitioners have filed this petition on 26-11-2025 stating therein that they are Hindus by faith and they are husband and wife in relation and their marriage was solemnized as per Hindu Rites and Customs on 17-11-2020 at the house of petitioner No-1. Since after that solemnization of marriage, they started living as husband and wife in the house of the petitioner no. 2.

In course of their joint living it was found that their temperament, habits, culture are different and despite best endeavor, it was not possible for their joint living and they started living separately on and from 28-10-2024.

They have filed joint petition praying for dissolution of their marriage tie by a decree of divorce on mutual consent.

They have also jointly filed standard parenting plan duly signed by them, recording the details provision regarding

maintenance of their child, visitation right and his custody. They agreed to obey the terms of the plan properly.

Both the petitioners have deposed before this Court. It appears from the testimonies of the petitioners that they are Hindus by faith and their marriage was solemnized on 17-11-2020 as per Hindu Rites and Customs. It also appears from their testimonies that they have been living separately on and from 28-10-2024.

It also reveals from their testimonies that on account of different temperament, habits, choices, culture and thinking they have not been able to live together and their relation has been strained to that extent that their living together as husband and wife is not possible. It also reveals that they have truly and freely agreed to the dissolution of marriage and there is no collusion in presenting the petition.

It is pertinent to mention here that the parties were called in the chamber of the P.O in which they have expressed their inability to drag this relation. In this factual aspect, this Court is of the opinion that their marriage tie should be dissolved so that they may start their life afresh.

Ordered

that Mat Suit no. 790 of 2025 be and the same is decreed on mutual consent without any order as to cost.
