Order No. 17 Dated 29/01/2026

Today is fixed for appearance of accused Sumilan Singh and Ashok Maji and E/R of W/A with respect to accused Tumpa Majhi.

Accused Sumilan Singh and Ashok Maji absent by petition and pray for time.

Prayer for time is allowed as last chance.

Sureties directed to produce absentee accused on next date i/d W/A will be issued.

Accused Tumpa Majhi who was brought under arrest yesterday is produced through audio video linkage.

Ld. Lawyer files an application on behalf of the accused person namely, Tumpa Majhi and prays for bail on the grounds stated therein.

Ld Advocate for the present accused person submits that she has falsely been implicated in this case and she will never abscond any further and thereby face trial and therefore the accused person may be released on bail.

Ld. P.P -in -charge raises objection to the bail prayer.

It transpires from the record that W.A was issued against her on 10.06.2025 after being named in charge-sheet.

Charge-sheet has already been filed in this case. Perused the case diary including statement of the V.G. under section 164 Cr.P.C. Considering the extent of complicity of this accused in alleged offences and fact that she is a lady with a lap baby I am inclined to enlarge her on bail.

Hence, the accused Tumpa Majhi may find interim bail of Rs. 2000/- with one surety, subject to satisfaction of Ld.ACJM, Basirhat with further condition to attend Court regularly hereinafter.

In addition accused person shall within 48 hours of her release from custody submit an affidavit disclosing her present and permanent addresses, contact numbers on which she shall remain available with undertaking not to change the same without intimation to the I.O. and the Court.
