	18.11.22	The case record is put-up today as the accused namely Jitu Sahu, S/o. Banamali Sahu, Vill-Tube, PS-Jarapada, Dist-Angul is present on being summoned. On being asked, the accused shows his inability to appoint a private lawyer. Accordingly Sri A. Mohanty appointed as SDC on behalf of him. The accused is taken into J/c. On perusal it is found that C.S had been submitted on dated 18.11.2022 U/s. 279 of IPC/185 MV Act, which is stated to the accused to which he pleads guilty and stated that he has committed the said offence. As such I convict the accused on his pleading guilty as per sec. 252 of Cr.PC. As the offence is against the state and public at large the accused is not get the benefit of the benevolent provision of the P.O. Act. As such the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- for commission of offence U/s. 279 of IPC in default he shall undergo S.I. for 5 days and to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- of commission of offence U/s. 185 of MV Act in default he shall undergo S.I. for 100 days.
