KHWAIRAKPAM SURANDA SINGH Vs. SUMEER MAHAJAN

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the appellant that there are 20 appeals (including the present appeal) pending between the parties herein. It is also submitted that all the 20 appeals have been settled with the respondent out of court for a sum of Rs.65 lacs in total and that the said amount has already been paid by the appellant to the respondent herein.

Vide judgment dated 29.07.2024, accused Suranda Singh was convicted and Rajeshwar Singh was acquitted. Thereafter, order on sentence was passed on 13.12.2024.

The copy of the receipt and copy of ID proof of the respondent are placed on record.

Permission is sought for the compounding of the offence U/s 138 NI Act. The statement of Ld. Counsel for appellant and also of the respondent are recorded separately. The respondent also confirms the submissions made by the Ld. Counsel for the appellant. The respondent also confirms the settlement and the receipt of the amount of settlement.

In view of the submissions and the statements made by both the parties, the offence U/s 138 NI Act stands compounded.

Bail bonds cancelled. Surety stands discharged.

A copy of the order be sent to the Ld. Trial Court alongwith TCR.
