

Order no. 09 dated 02.06.26

Today is fixed for order.

The case record is taken up for passing order.

Petitioner/wife Asha Mukherjee files hazira.

Petitioner is examined as P.W.-1.

Heard the submission of Ld. Lawyer for petitioner/wife.

Inspite of having notice respondent/husband did not contest the suit. Thus, the suit proceeded ex-parte.

The record is taken up for passing ex-parte order.

Perused the case record and also unchallenged testimony of petitioner i.e. P.W.-1.

From where it appears the case of the petitioner in short is that the petitioner and the respondent are husband and wife. Their marriage was solemnized on 22.06.2015 according to Hindu rites and customs. It is further case that after the marriage petitioner and the respondent started living as husband and wife and their marriage was consummated. It is further case that after passing few days she was subjected to torture both physically and mentally on different plea. On 03.11.2021 respondent driven out petitioner from her matrimonial home. It is further alleged that in the meantime she was made several attempts to reconcile the matter but all goes in vain and having no alternative instant suit has been filed by her with a prayer for granting divorce against the respondent/husband. In support of her case she has adduced the evidence of herself as P.W.-1 which is unchallenged on record.

Considering the above fact and circumstances in the light of available unchallenged testimony of P.W.-1 where I find that she has made out her case, according I am of the opinion that she is entitled to get the decree as prayed for.

Thus, the suit succeeds.

C.F paid is correct.

O R D E R E D

That the suit be and same is decreed ex-parte but without costs.

The petitioner namely Asha Mukherjee do get the decree of divorce.

The marriage tie between petitioner namely Asha Mukherjee and respondent namely Shyamapada Mukherjee was solemnized on 22.06.2015 is hereby dissolved from the date of this order.
