J U D G M E N T

This is a petition u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954.

Both the petitioners have filed this petition on 25-11-2025 stating therein that Petitioner-1(wife) and petitioner-2(husband) are Hindu by faith and they are husband and wife in relation and their marriage was registered and solemnized on 05-06-2012. Since after that solemnization of marriage, they started living as husband and wife in the house of the petitioner no. 2. In course of their joint living it was found that their habits, tastes, culture and opinion are different and despite best endeavor, it was not possible for their joint living and both the petitioners decided to live separately as per their own will on and from 13-05-2019 and since then they have been living separately.

They have filed joint petition praying for dissolution of their marriage tie by a decree of divorce on mutual consent.

They have also jointly filed standard parenting plan duly signed by them, recording the details provision regarding maintenance of their child, visitation right and custody of the child. Both the Ld. Advocates are also present.

Both the petitioners have deposed before this Court as P.W.-1 and 2 respectively. The original marriage certificate is marked exhibit- 1. From their testimonies, it appears that their marriage was registered and solemnized on 05-06-2012 under the Special Marriage Act, 1954. It further appears from the testimonies of P.W.1 and P.W.2 that after marriage they started living as husband and wife at the house of petitioner no.2 and both the petitioners decided to live separately as per their own will on and from 13-05-

2019 and since then they have been living separately from each others. It also reveals from their testimonies that after few months of their marriage dispute and controversy arose between them. They picked up quarrel in trifling issues and their relation has been stained to that extent that their living together as husband and wife is not possible. It also reveals that they have truly and freely agreed to the dissolution of marriage and there is no collusion in presenting the petition. It is pertinent to mention here that the parties have expressed their inability to drag this relation further and thus the process of reconciliation failed. In this factual aspect, this Court is of the opinion that their marriage tie should be dissolved so that they may start their life afresh.

C.F paid is correct.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the Matrimonial tie in between the petitioner no. 1 and 2, namely, **Smt. Sudipta Mondal and Shri Krishanu Mondal** is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent.

The decree of divorce shall take effect from this date.
