The complainant namely, **Rama Bapari** is examined under section 200 of the Cr.P.C in full.

Perused the case record. It appears from the perusal of the case record along with the initial deposition of the complainant, I am of the view that matters need to be investigated first as the accused person resides beyond the jurisdiction of this court and as per the provision of Section 202(1) of Cr.P.C. it is incumbent upon this Court to postpone the issuance of process against the accused and direct an investigation to be made first if the accused person is residing beyond the jurisdiction of the Court, for the purpose of deciding whether or not there is a sufficient ground for proceeding in this case. As such, the issuance of process against the accused person is postponed.

Therefore, **I/C, Mohonpur P.S** is directed to investigate the matter and send a report to this Court U/s 202 of Cr PC within the next date fixed for hearing.
