Accused are examined u/s 251 Cr.P.C. The substance of accusation u/s 138 N.I. Act to the effect that “in discharge of the liability owed to the complainant you issued one cheque bearing no.000004 dt.03.01.2021 for the cheque for an amount of Rs.5,40,000/- which when presented by the complainant for encashment to her banker got dishonoured with remarks 'insufficient fund' and thereafter you were served with a notice of demand but you failed to return the dishonoured cheque amount to the complainant” is read over and explained to the accused in Bengali to which she pleaded not guilty saying “NIRDOSH” and claimed to be tried.
