The complainant namely, Madhysudan Nayak is present.

Complainant is examined on S/A, under section 223 BNSS.

Perused the complaint petition and the statement of the complainant on SA u/s 223 BNSS and the affidavit in chief of the complainant.

Having considered the materials on record, it appears that there is prima facie case for proceeding against the accused person under sections 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act.

Accordingly I am of the view that there is no bar to issue process against the accused person u/s 227 BNSS the Code.

The accused person is given opportunity to compound the instant case at the initial stage by depositing the principal amount of the alleged **one** cheque of **Rs.15,00,000/-** along with 7% interest from the date of issuance of cheque and Rs 5,000/- as cost at the time of making his appearance in this court in connection with this case if he is intending to compound the alleged offence.

Requisites at once.

To **10.9.26** for S/R, appearance and deposit of amount in the judicial cash or payment of the same in the hands of the complainant, if intending to compound.
