AWARD

This petition has been filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act seeking for compensation of Rs. 27,00,000/- for the injuries sustained in a motor accident.

2. A joint compromise memo dated 14.07.2026 is filed wherein the petitioner and the 2nd respondent have agreed to settle the dispute for a sum of Rs. 5,75,000/- as full quit of the claim. The contesting parties prayed for a compromise award. Recorded.

3. In view of the compromise, a compromise award is passed in the

above terms.

4. In fine,

(a) The 2nd Respondent is directed to pay the compensation of **Rs.5,75,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs and Seventy Five Thousand Only)** within six weeks from today.

(b) The 2nd petitioner is entitled to 50% and the petitioners 3 and 4 are entitled to 25%.

(c) In default of depositing the same within the stipulated time, the said amount shall carry an interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of award till the date of its actual deposit.

(d) Insofar as the mode of disbursement of compensation is concerned, it is brought to the notice of this Tribunal that the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Parminder Singh v. Honey Goyal & Ors., 2025 INSC 361 : 2025 LiveLaw (SC) 318***, has held that the compensation amount shall be directly transferred to the bank account of the claimant, without requiring deposit before the Tribunal. In the present case, the petitioner has already furnished his bank account particulars before this Tribunal, of which the 2nd Respondent has due notice.

(e) That there shall be no costs.
