Order:-

ASI Paramjit Singh, No.323.Kpt PS Dhilwan, appeared
and suffered a statement to the effect that the applicant/accused has
joined the investigation but has not recovered the datar i.e. weapon
of offence.

2. Ld. Addl.PP for the State argued that the above mentioned
applicant-accused has joined the investigation in the present case but has
not got recovered the weapon used for the commission of offence. The

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learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued that the accused/applicant has not caused any injury to the complainant party and has not used any such officer. The allegations and counter allegations are matter of trial. Moreover, pending recovery if any, it could not be considered a hurdle to confirm the interim anticipatory bail to the applicant/accused. Relied upon Bhupinder Singh etc. Vs. State of Punjab, reported in 2014(2) RCR(Criminal) 109(P&H), wherein it is held that an anticipatory bail could not be rejected on the ground for pending recovery to be effected from the applicants. Hence, interim anticipatory bail order stands confirmed. So, keeping in view above facts and circumstances, since applicants/accused has joined investigation, in pursuance of interim Order dated 01.09.2025, and the allegations levelled are matter of trial, so the interim order dated 01.09.2025, stands confirmed and made absolute, subject to the applicant continuing to appear before the Investigation agency as and when summoned and subject to his continuing to comply with the conditions envisaged in order dated 01.09.2025. Record of the present bail application be attached with the remand papers, if any, otherwise be consigned to the record room(J), Kapurthala.
