1. Today is fixed for taking appropriate steps by the petitioner, failing which necessary orders shall be passed.
2. The learned Advocate for the petitioner appears and files hazira along with an application under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, registered as I.A. No. 01/2026, praying for amendment of the addresses of respondent Nos. 5, 6 and 7 in the cause title. The learned Advocate also files a petition praying for time to take necessary steps for initiating arbitration proceedings in accordance with law.
3. Respondent No. 4, namely Mr. Ashis Kr. Sarkar, appears in person and files hazira.
4. Heard the learned Advocate for the petitioner and Respondent No. 4, who is present in Court. It is submitted by the learned Advocate for the petitioner that the addresses of respondent Nos. 5, 6 and 7 have changed and, therefore, the cause title requires amendment by incorporating their present addresses for proper adjudication of the instant case. It is further submitted that the proposed amendment is merely formal and technical in nature and does not alter the nature and character of the case.
5. Upon consideration of the materials on record and the submissions made, it appears that the proposed amendment is formal in nature and is confined to incorporation of the changed addresses of respondent Nos. 5, 6 and 7. The proposed amendment neither changes the nature and character of the case nor causes any prejudice to the respondents.
6. Accordingly, the application under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure is allowed and disposed of. Leave is granted to the petitioner to amend the cause title in terms of the proposed amendment as stated in the application. Consequently, **I.A. No. 01/2026** stands disposed of.

7. Fix **03.09.2026** for filing the amended cause title and for taking appropriate steps by the petitioner with regard to initiation of arbitration proceedings in accordance with law.
