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This is private complaint instituted in the year 2020 for offences punishable under sections 323, 504, 506 r.w. 34 of Indian Penal Code. The case is pending for dismissal order since long. No steps have been taken by the complainant since long time. Roznama shows that, matter was kept for dismissal order on 11/04/2026 and 16/05/2026.

02. In view of Section 244 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr. P.C.'), it was the duty of complainant to produce evidence in support of prosecution. As per Section 245(2) of the Cr. P. C., the Court shall discharge the accused at any previous stage, if he considers the charge to be groundless. In the instant matter, there is no evidence produced in support of prosecution, however failed to proceed further. In absence of evidence, no case can be made out. It is pertinent to note that from the absence of the complainant for such long period it appears that complainant also does not want to proceed with the trial. In view of discussion supra, I am of the considered opinion that no case is made out against the accused. It is

fit case to dispose off. In the result, following order is passed:-

ORDER

01.	The accused No.1.Sallaudin Rukmoddin Majkuri and 2.Pandhari Mahadu Vante are discharged under Section 245(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure.
02.	The bail bonds of the accused nos.1 & 2 are discharged, if any.
03.	The proceedings is hereby stand disposed off.
