Bail application moved on behalf of accused.

Arguments heard on bail application.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that
accused has been falsely implicated in the present case;
charge-sheet of present case has been filed without arrest of
accused; applicant/accused has clean antecedents; he is ready to
abide by all the conditions imposed by the court. Thus, Ld.
Counsel has prayed for grant of bail to the applicant/accused.

Per contra, Ld. Addl. PP duly assisted by Ld. counsel
for complainant has opposed the bail application by referring to the
serious nature of offence alleged against them in the FIR. Thus, it
is prayed that bail application be dismissed.

Arguments considered.

Charge-sheet has been filed against applicant/accused
for the offence under Section 3(1)(r)(s) of SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989,

on the allegations that accused uttered casteist remarks against the complainant in the presence of witnesses namely Umesh Gupta and Abhishek Sharma.

Chargesheet has been filed 'without arrest' of accused; accused not being arrested during investigation, is indicative of the fact that he cooperated during the course of the same with the investigating agency. The purpose of bail is to secure the presence of accused and as per record, there is nothing on record to show that there is any apprehension that accused will flee from trial. Last but not the least, considering the fact that recording of evidence is likely to take considerable time, application in hand stand allowed. As far as, apprehension, if any on behalf of prosecution that complainant may be intimidated or influenced in case accused/applicant is released on bail, may be allayed by imposing strict conditions.

In the totality of facts and circumstances, accused Anand Ram Anand Chaudhary is admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bond in the sum of **Rs.30,000/-** with one surety and personal bond of like amount to the satisfaction of this court/Duty JMFC subject to the following conditions that:-

- 1. Applicant shall not threaten or influence the complainant or any prosecution witness in any manner whatsoever.*
- 2. Applicant shall not tamper with the evidence nor shall indulge in any illegal activities during the bail period.*
- 3. Applicant and his surety shall intimate this Court immediately of any change in their addresses and shall also furnish their mobile numbers to the IO/SHO concerned.*

Bail application stands disposed off.

Copy of chargesheet not supplied to complainant. IO
be called for next date to supply the same.
