Today is fixed for hearing of the petition u/s 151 of the CPC dated 20.07.2024 filed by the judgment debtor.

Decree holder file hazira through his Ld. Advocate.

An application has been filed by the judgment debtor praying for adjournment on the ground that the conducting Ld. Advocate has recently undergone an appendix operation and is recuperating at hospital, and, as such, he is unable to attend the Court today.

Surgical pathology report and xerox copy of the certificate dated 12.08.2025 has been annexed.

None appears on behalf of the judgment debtor to make any submission.

On the last occasion i.e. on 23.07.2025 also similar application had been filed by the judgment debtor and this Court had granted adjournment with an observation that reasonable time is being given to the judgment debtor, so that even if the Ld. Advocate is unable to attend the Court on the next day due to his illness, he can arrange for some alternatives. But, this day also adjournment has been sought on the ground of the illness of the conducting Ld. Advocate. The Surgical pathology report shows that the patient has already been discharged. However, it does not show when was he discharged but the same report had been submitted on the last occasion also. The SAT No. 91 of 2025 with CAN No. 01 of 2025 has already been dismissed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of the Calcutta High Court vide order dated 09.06.2025.

The conduct of the judgment debtor speaks of his utter disregard to the direction of the Court and he did not even choose to make submission in respect of the application filed this day though the same has been signed by an Advocate. Sufficient opportunity has already been given to the judgment debtor. Giving further opportunity would mean giving unwarranted indulgence to the judgment debtor jeopardizing the interest of the decree holder.

In view of the above, I am not inclined to grant further adjournment to the judgment debtor, hence, the application is rejected. The application u/s 151 of the CPC dated 20.07.2024 is rejected without going into merit of the application.
