Today is fixed for argument of the petition under Rule-208 of the Civil Rules and Orders. The decree holder as well as judgment debtor file separate attendance through their respective Ld. Advocates.

It appears from the record that the judgment debtor appeared in the execution case on 12.03.2025 and filed two separate applications, one with a prayer for stay of the Miscellaneous case and another with a prayer for filing written objection against the petition under Rule-208 of the Civil Rules and Orders.

Though the evidences for the decree holder have been recorded *ex parte* in absence of the judgment debtor as the execution case has been filed within the statutory period but as the judgement debtor has appeared *suo moto*, he should get a chance of contesting the petition under Rule 208 of Civil Rules and Orders.

Accordingly the decree holder is directed to serve copy of the petition under Rule 208 of Civil Rules and Orders upon he judgment debtor.

The judgment debtor is directed to file the written objection against the said petition within 30 days from the date of receipt of the same, I.d. argument will be heard.

Fix 12-06-2025 for hearing of the petition for stay. W/O, if any, by the decree holder in the mean time.
