Vide this order I shall dispose off an application filed on behalf of applicant/accused **Ashish Diliprao Samrit** seeking issuance of no objection from this court so as to obtain fresh passport.

Reply to the application has been filed today. Copy supplied.

It is submitted by Ld. counsel that applicant/accused that the applicant/accused has applied for issuance of passport for which no objection of this court is required in view of the pendency of instant case. It is also submitted that in view of the same, instant application be allowed.

On the other hand, it has been submitted on behalf of CBI that after completion of investigation final report in the form closure has already been filed and thus, in view of the same, appropriate order as deem fit may be passed on the application.

I have heard the arguments on behalf of both the sides. Perused.

Considering the totality of facts and circumstance, this court has no objection, if the applicant/accused **Ashish Diliprao Samrit** is issued a fresh passport for a period of ten years, by the concerned authority in accordance with law and rules laid down in this regard.

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Needless to say, it goes without saying that accused/applicant **Ashish Diliprao Samrit** shall take prior permission of this court in the event of his being traveling out of India in terms of order dated 04.12.2021.

Application stands disposed off.
