ORDER NO. 18 DATED 11.11.2022

Today is fixed for hearing of the petition under Sec.7(2) of the W.B.P.T. Act.

Received copy of one order of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta passed in C.O. No.1827 of 2022 under Memo No.3061D dated 19.10.2022 from Asstt. Registrar, Hight Court, Calcutta.

Hon'ble Court has been pleased to pass an order “.....*The impugned order is thus set aside with a direction upon the court below to rehear the same afresh, providing sufficient opprtunity of hearing to either of the paties to this, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable, preferably within four weeks after the Puja Vacation of the court below*”.

Both parties have filed their respective haziras.

Defendant has also filed examination in chief on affidavit of one Bijay Bhushan Jaiswal alias Bijay Jaiswal in respect of petition under Sec.7(2) of the W. B. P. T. Act. Copy served. Let it be kept with the record.

Ld. Advocates for both sides are present.

The record is taken up for evidence in respect of petition under Sec.7(2).

Bijay Bhusan Jaiswal alias Bijay Jaiswal is examined in chief as AP.W.I in full and trhe documents filed by him are marked as Ext.-1 to Ext.-3 collectively and cross examined in full and discharged.

At this stage, ld. Advocate for the defendant has filed one petition praying for time for adducing further evidence and another petition praying for issuing summons to one Bidyabhusan Jaiswal of 19, Durga Pithuri Lane, Kolkata-12 on the ground stated therein.

Heard ld. Advocates for both sides.

Prayers of the defendant are considered and allowed.

Issue summons to witness as per prayer of the petition of the defendant accordingly.

Fix 17.11.2022 for further evidence of defendant/petitioner in respect of petition under Sec.7(2) of the W. B. P. T. Act.
