Today is fixed for taking steps by the surviving plaintiff. Both the parties file separate attendance through their respective Ld. Advocates.

At this stage the surviving plaintiff files a petition with a prayer for expunging the name of plaintiff no.2, since deceased.

Copy served.

Heard for plaintiff in full. None turned up for the defendant on repeated calls.

Perused the record. Considered.

Perusal of the case record reveals that the petition contemplates an order striking out the name of plaintiff no.2 from the cause title of the plaint because she has expired on 18.09.2025 and except plaintiff no.3 she did not have any other legal heirs.

As the legal heirs of the deceased plaintiff no.2 is already on record, there is no question of abatement. So the prayer of the plaintiff shall be allowed.

For that, it is

ORDERED

That let the name of the deceased plaintiff no.2, Aparna Das be struck out from the cause title of the plaint as dead by making necessary corrections in the cause title of the plaint.

Let the petition dated 08.01.2026 be treated as a part of the plaint.

D.A. to do necessary corrections and insertions.

The petition dated 08.01.2026 is thus disposed of without contest and costs.
