Today is fixed for hearing of petition u/s 7(2) of W.B.P.T Act filed by the defendant on 07-12-17. Ld advocates for the parties are present at the time of call. The petition u/s 7(2) of W.B.P.T Act filed by the defendant is taken up for hearing.

Ld advocate for the defendant has submitted that all the rents have been paid properly. There is no due in payment of rent. He has filed challans to this effect in Court.

Ld advocate for the plaintiff has submitted that he has gone through the challans filed by the defendant in respect of payment of rent . The challans are found to be correct and the rents have been paid properly.

Heard both sides, perused the petition and materials on record. Considered.

After going through the challans and considering the submissions of the parties , I find that the rent has been properly paid by the defendant. So, the petition u/s 7(2) of W.B.P.T Act stands allowed. It is held that no rent is due and payable by the defendant up to this stage. Written statement has already been filed in this case.
