ORDER NO. 17 DATED 21.01.2019

Both parties file hazira.

Ld. Counsels for both parties are present on call.

The application of the plaintiff under Or.6 R.17 read with Sec.151 C.P.C. dated 22.06.2017 is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides. Perused the petition, written objection and the materials available on record.

It apparently transpires that during the pendency of the instant suit, son of Plaintiff no.4 has become major and wants to start his livelihood through a business and the subsequent chain of events have followed subsequently.

I am of the view that the proposed amendments are formal in nature and will definitely not change the nature and character of the instant suit and are necessary for complete and effective adjudication of the controversy that have cropped up between the parties.

The instant application under Or.6 R.17 C.P.C. is thus allowed on contest but without any order as to cost.

Plaintiff is permitted to amend his pleadings as per schedule of his amendment application.

B.C.II is directed to register the same accordingly.

Plaintiff is directed to file the amended copy of plaint by the date fixed.

Fix 08.02.2019 for filing amended copy of plaint and further order.
