Defendant is hereby permitted to pay/deposit the current rent commencing from the month of **October, 2025** there after month by

month by 15th of each succeeding month at his own risk whenever fallen due, without prejudice to the right and contentions of the parties in accordance with law.

Defendant is also permitted to pay / deposit the admitted arrear of rent as prayed for, calculated at the rate at which it was last paid and up to the end of the month previous to that in which the payment is made together with interest @ 10% p.a. within the time frame as prescribed under the law at his own risk without prejudice to the right and contentions of the parties. .

To date (04-11-2025) for hearing of petition u/s 7(2) of W.B.P.T. Act, w/o if any in the meantime. Defendant is required to file written statement within the prescribed period of limitation.

Defendant is directed to serve the copy of petitions upon the plaintiff in the meantime.
