**Dated 12.06.2025 :**

Today is fixed for filing of written objection by the judgment debtor against the petition under Rule-208 of the Civil Rules and Orders and hearing of the petition of stay. The decree holder as well as judgment debtor file separate attendance through their respective Ld. Advocates.

No written objection is filed by the judgment debtor against the petition under section-208 of the Civil Rules and Orders. Rather it is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the judgment debtor that he will not file any written objection but he wants to cross examine the witnesses of the petitioner and the Court bailiff.

The prayer is allowed.

The decree holders have not filed the written objection against the petition for stay.

On perusal of the said petition it appears that the judgment debtor prayed for stay of the proceeding of miscellaneous case. But there is no existence of such miscellaneous case. So the petition for stay is misconceived. Hence it is rejected.
