It appears from the bailiff report that, notice was unserved upon the defendant no 2 as the room of the said defendant was closed under lock and key. Bailiff has affixed the notice on the front door of the room of the said defendant and took a photograph thereof, which is annexed with bailiff report.

No postal report has yet come.

On perusal of the postal track report it appears that, summons was unserved through postal mode of service as 'item returned no such person in the address'.

Under such circumstances, summons upon the defendant no 2 could not be served in an ordinary manner. Plaintiff is directed to take necessary step for service of summons upon the defendant no 2 in accordance with the law.
