Today is fixed for hearing of the petition under Rule 208 of the Civil Rules and Orders. The decree holders file attendance through their Ld. Advocate. Decree holder no.1 is present and files written examination in chief on affidavit form. One petition has been filed on behalf of the judgment debtor with a prayer for time.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the judgment debtor. Perused the record.

Considered.

It appears from the record that on the previous occasion also adjournment was sought for on behalf of the judgement debtor for filing of the written objection. The copy of the petition under Rule 208 of the Civil Rules and Orders was served upon the judgment debtor on 22.03.2023. But till date he could not prepare the written objection. This Court is not inclined to adjourn the case any further waiting for the written objection.

Accordingly the prayer for time is rejected.

The record is taken up for evidence.

Decree holder no.1, Minati Das duly tendered the written examination in chief on affidavit form and has been examined in chief as PW-1 in full and discharged. The cross examination of PW-1 by the judgment debtor is deemed to be declined.

1. The signatures of PW-1 on the back side of the writ-- Exhibit-1 and 1/1.
2. Note given by PW-1 on the back side of the writ-- Exhibit-1/2.

Ld. Advocate for the decree holders submitted that the evidence of the Court bailiff is necessary and he may be permitted to summon the Court bailiff.

The prayer is allowed.

The record is adjourned for the evidence of the Court bailiff.
