Today is fixed for awaiting office report and awaiting report from another department.

Today plaintiffs files a petition praying for withdrawal of the suit on the ground stated therein.

Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs moved the petition and submitted that the plaintiffs had filed the instant suit against the defendants for eviction but during the pendency of the suit, the dispute between the parties have been settled amicably out of Court and as such the plaintiffs are not willing to proceed with the suit and is praying for withdrawal of the same.

In support of his case, plaintiffs adduced evidence of the plaintiff no-1 Najmul Abedin on dock as P.W-1 who proved documents which are marked as Ext-1 & 2, along with the photocopies. P.W-1 is examined in full and discharged and original documents returned.

By filing the instant application, plaintiffs are praying for withdrawal of the suit .

Record reveals that the defendants have yet to enter in the suit.

The instant petition of the plaintiffs are supported by the affidavit of the plaintiff no-1 who has been duly authorized to sign in the petition and affidavit on behalf of all the other plaintiffs.

Plaintiff no-1 is also on affidavit affirming that the plaintiffs hve settled the dispute with the defendant out of Court and is willing to withdraw the suit.

Therefore, considering such factual aspect, this Court finds that prayer of the plaintiffs may be allowed.

it is

Ordered

that the petition filed by the plaintiffs dt 19/05/2026 is hereby considered and allowed.

Accordingly the Ejectment Suit 304 of 2025 be and the same stands dismissed treated as withdrawn by plaintiff.
