Today is fixed for hearing of petitions u/s 7(1) & 7(2) of W.B.P T Act, w/o if any in the mean time with further direction upon the defendant to file Written Statement within the prescribed period of limitation.

Today plaintiff files hazia .

Plaintiff also files two separate written objections , one against the petition u/s 7(1) & another against the petition u/s 7(2) of W.B.P T Act filed by the defendant dated 18-02-2025. Copies not served but attached.

Defendant files a petition praying for adjournment on the ground stated therein. Copy served. Objection noted.

On call, Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff is found present.

But on repeated calls, none appears to move the adjournment petition filed by the defendant.

Considering such lackadaisical attitude of the defendant, this Court finds that the petition for adjournment filed by the defendant stands rejected. As none moved the petitions u/s 7(1) & 7(2) of W.B.P T Act, the said petitions also stands rejected.

No W/S has yet been filed.

Accordingly, the suit shall proceed ex-parte against the defendant.

Let the case be **transferred** to the Court of Ld. Judge, **2nd Bench** Presidency Small Cause Court, Calcutta for disposal.

Plaintiff is directed to appear before the transferee Court on (**14-05-2025**)
