Today is fixed for hearing of the petition under Section 7(2) of the WBPT Act, 1997 hearing of the petition Under Order-6, Rule-17 r/w Section 151 of the CPC and the petition Under order-39, Rule 1 & 2 r/w Section of the 151 of the CPC and the petition under Order-39, Rule-7 r/w Section 151 of the CPC, written objection, if any, in the meantime.
