Petitioner/landlord files a petition supported by an affidavit under Sec.47 read with Sec.151 of C.P.C.

An application under Sec.47 of C.P.C. ought to be registered as a Misc. Case in terms of Civil Rules and Orders framed by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta. Thus, a direct filing to the Court is not permissible.

Therefore, the petition under Sec.47 of C.P.C. stands rejected without any order as to merits.

Admittedly, no stay of proceedings of the instant Execution has been passed by any higher forum.

Considering the same, there is no impediment to proceed with the Execution.

Fix 27.09.2024 for delivery of possession and fix 01.10.2024 for Bailiff's report.
