1. Two separate applications have been moved on behalf of applicant/accused for modification of the bail condition in order dated 19.02.2026 and for seeking permission to join the investigation through video conferencing from Chennai on medical grounds.
2. Condition was imposed on the applicant/accused in Para 13 (b) of the bail order dated 19.02.2026 to appear before the IO on the first Saturday of every month at 11:00 AM. However, it is stated that the applicant could not abide by the said condition and therefore, failed to appear before the IO because of medical conditions which are stated in the application. Medical record along with the Discharge Summary is also annexed with the application.
3. In these circumstances, though the Court is not inclined to modify the condition in Para 13 (b), but in view of the medical conditions, he is exempted from appearance for this month, as the first Saturday has already passed, with directions to appear positively on the first Saturday

of the next month and thereby, abide by the condition imposed vide bail order dated 19.02.2026.

4. Both the applications are disposed off accordingly.
5. Copy of this order be given dasti to the Investigating Officer and the counsel for the applicant/accused.
