Plaintiff filed hazira. Defendant absent without step. No cause shown by the defendant inspite of specific direction on the last occasion due to absence without step of the defendant. Accordingly the plaintiff's petition u/s 7 (3) of the W.B.P.T. ACT dt.25/03/21 is taken up for passing order.

On perusal of the case record it appears that vide order no. 30 dt.18/02/20 the petition u/s 7(2) of the W.B.P.T. ACT has been rejected due non compliance of the order u/s 7 (1) of the W.B.P.T. ACT. And accordingly in view of t he said order the plaintiff's petition u/s 7(3) of the W.B.P.T. ACT is hereby allowed and the defence of the defendant against delivery of possession is hereby struck off.
