Order below Exh.3 in Sessions Case No.434/2019
[CNR NO.MHTH060035942019]

1] This is an application made by the applicant/accused No.4 **Rohan Rahul Bhalerao** for issuance of directions to the passport authority to renew his passport No.K4301412.

2] The charge-sheet bearing Sessions Case No.434/2019 is filed against the applicant/accused for the offence punishable under sections 364, 384, 395, 120-B of IPC in the court and matter is pending for charge. The applicant/accused want to renew his passport, however, due to pendency of the aforesaid case, there is a bar under section 6(2) (f) of the Passport Act, 1967 for issuance/renewal of passport. As per the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India Notification No.GSR 570(E), dated August 25, 1993, there is an exemption to the citizen of India against whom proceeding in respect of an offence alleged to have been committed by them are pending before the Criminal Court in India and who produced order from the court concerned permitting them to depart from India from the operation of the aforesaid provision of clause (f) of sub-section (2) of section 6 of the said Act. Thus, the applicant has made this application for seeking no objection as per the aforesaid Notification for renewing the passport as per the provisions of the Passport Act, 1967.

3] Perused the application, say thereon and record of the case. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant/accused and Ld. APP for the State. The applicant is already on bail. He is residing in Adharwadi, Kalyan, District Thane. He is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the court. Mere pendency of a criminal case is not a ground to refuse “no objection” for issuance/renewal of passport to the accused, who otherwise entitled for the same. There is no ground available which discard the issuance of no objection to the applicant for renewing the passport. Hence, the application is allowed as per following order :

Order

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] This court has no objection if the Passport Authority renew passport of applicant/accused No.4 **Rohan Rahul Bhalerao** bearing Passport No.K4301412.
- 3] The accused shall always inform and take prior permission of this court regarding his visits, date of departure, date of arrival regarding every foreign trip, if any.
- 4] He is further directed to appear on each dates in the trial of the aforesaid case before this court.
- 5] Inform the Police and Passport Authority accordingly.
