P.W.-1 namely Mathew Probir Rozario is examined in chief in part.

P.W.-1 files two Registered Deed of Conveyance which are marked as Ext. 1(series), counterparts of receipts marked as Ext. 2 (collectively), appointment letter dated 25.04.2023 marked as Ext. 3, certificate issued by the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes marked as Ext. 4, certificate issued by the Bengal Tax Counsel Pvt. Ltd marked as Ext. 5.

At this stage, plaintiff files a petition for defer of examination-in-chief for filing some more documents.

Heard. Perused the petition and materials on record.

Record reveals that the instant suit was earlier decreed ex-parte on 08.11.2019 and during the course of evidence, plaintiff had filed some documents which were marked as Ext. 1 to Ext. 10. Subsequently, on 17.12.2021 plaintiff had withdraw all the original exhibited documents except Ext. 10.
