

Ejectment Suit No. 106 of 2022

Dated 10.07.2025 :

Today is fixed for peremptory hearing of the suit. Both the parties file separate attendance through their respective Ld. Advocates. Arijit Dhar, the authorized person of the plaintiff is present and files written examination in chief on affidavit form and some documents by way of firisti.

The record is taken up for peremptory hearing.

Arijit Dhar duly tendered the written examination in chief on affidavit form and has been examined in chief as PW-1 in full and cross examined by the defendant in part.

Ld. Advocate for the defendant files a petition with a prayer for time to further cross examine the witness.

The prayer is allowed.

During the examination in chief of PW-1 the following documents are exhibited:

1. Letter of authority-- Exhibit-1.
2. Property tax bill-- Exhibit-2.
3. Copy of eviction notice-- Exhibit-3.
4. Postal receipt and the A/D card-- Exhibit-3/1 collectively.
5. Counterpart of the rent bill-- Exhibit-4.
6. Original voter identity card of the family members of PW-1 along with the attested photocopies of the same-- Exhibit-5 collectively and simultaneously.
7. Original Aadhar cards of PW-1 and his family members along with the attested photocopy of the same-- Exhibit-6 collectively and simultaneously.

At this stage the plaintiff files a petition with a prayer for withdrawal of the original voter identity cards and Adhaar cards.

Heard. Perused the record.

The plaintiff has filed the photocopies of the voter identity cards and Adhaar cards which are attested by the Notary and the Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff also verified the same with the original. So this Court does not find any hindrances to return the original voter identity cards and Adhaar cards.

Accordingly the prayer is allowed.

Let the original voter identity cards and Adhaar cards being Exhibit-5 and 6 be returned to the plaintiff on condition to produce the same as and when called for.
