This petition coming up for hearing before me on 29.05.2025 and upon perusing the material papers and records and upon hearing the arguments of M/s. R.Rafi Babu, P.Natarajan, K.Mahalakshmi, Learned counsel for the petitioner/accused and Mr.K.J.Saravanan, Learned Special Public Prosecutor for respondent/complainant, this court doth make the following:-

ORDER

This petition filed U/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

2. Heard. Records perused. The petitioner is the 3rd accused in Crime No.108/2025 of G-5 Secretariat Colony P.S. He alleged to have committed the offence u/s. 8(c) r/w 22(b), 29(1), 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985. This petitioner/Accused along with co-accused had been detained in prison on 01.05.2025. Now the petitioner/ accused has come forward with the present petition to enlarge

him on bail. According to the case of the prosecution, the petitioner/accused had possessed 16 grams of Methamphetamine for sale and the same had been seized by the respondent police. It has been urged that the petitioner/accused is innocent and he had been falsely implicated in the case. The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused had submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he is in no way connected with this case and the seized contraband is of intermediate quantity and he is ready to abide by any condition imposed by this court and this is the first bail application before this court and no similar petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court / any other court. The learned Special Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner/accused is having 3 No's of previous cases under NDPS Act and the investigation of this case is in initial stage and goondas proposal is pending against this petitioner. It has been putforth that if he is enlarged on bail, he would escape and commit similar offence and tamper the witnesses.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
