This is an application for bail U/s.483 of B.N.S.S.. The petitioner is in custody being implicated in GR.1041/2026, corresponding to Bellaguntha PS case no.336 dtd.13.06.2026, now pending in the Court of SDJM, Bhanjanagar for alleged commission of offences U/ss.296/115(2)/74/109(1)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS

At the foot of the bail application, a certificate has been furnished that no similar petition is pending in any other court having jurisdiction. As such, the bail application is taken up for consideration. Heard on the prayer for bail.

Prosecution allegation is that on 13.06.2026 at 4.05 PM the complainant Bishnukala Jena appeared at Bellaguntha PS and presented a written report to the effect that about 7 months back the land dispute among their family members was settled amicably through intervention of police on 13.06.2026 at 12 noon the complainant arranged tractor for cultivation of her land. At that time the present petitioner on his brother Sameer Jena and their mother Sumati Jena arrived near such land and started abusing the complainant in absence word and threatened her to kill. When the

son of the complainant namely Subham Sekhar Jena and her daughter Laxmi Jena tried to conciliate the matter, the accused persons including the present petitioner assaulted the son of complainant Subham Sekhar Jena on his head by means of iron rod as a result he sustained bleeding injury on his head and swelling on his leg. The daughter of the complainant also sustained injury on her head due to assault by the accused persons.

Basing upon such report of the informant , Bellaguntha PS case no.336 dtd.13.06.2026 for offence U/ss.296/115(2)/74/109(1)/ 351(2)/3(5) of BNS was registered and the matter was investigated into. During investigation, the petitioner was arrested and forwarded to court on 14.06.2026. After completion of investigation, charge sheet for offences U/ss.296/115(2)/74/109(1)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS has been submitted against the petitioner.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was moved before the learned SDJM, Bhanjanagar and after hearing, the same has been rejected by him, vide order dated 04.08.2026. Being aggrieved by such order, the petitioner has preferred this bail application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations made against the petitioner are false. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a permanent resident of village Mandara under Bellaguntha PS in the district of Ganjam. It is further submitted that the petitioner was released on interim bail from 02.07.2026 to 04.08.2026 on the ground of appearing his examination and he has surrendered before the court after completion

of his interim bail period. Investigation of the case has already been completed. Hence prayed for release of the petitioner on bail.

On the contrary, learned Addl.PP has orally opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner citing nature and gravity of the offence.

Perused the case record. The petitioner is involved in offences U/ss.296/115(2)/74/109(1)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS. Investigation of the case has already been completed in the meantime. The petitioner has surrendered before the court below after completion of interim bail period granted to him. The petitioner is a permanent resident of village Mandara under Bellaguntha PS within the territorial jurisdiction of this court. There is no chance of his absconding. It will take some time to complete investigation as well as trial.

Regard being had to the nature of accusation and completion of investigation, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Let the petitioner **Subham Jena** be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty-five thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM, Bhanjanagar with conditions that:-

- (i) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any criminal activity while on bail,
- (ii) He shall not threaten or terrorize the informant or any other prosecution witness in any manner while on bail and

(iii) He shall remain present personally in court on each date of posting of the case till conclusion of trial.

Violation of any condition shall entail cancellation of bail.
