

Puran Ram Vs Sub Divisional Magistrate

Present: Revision petitioner Suresh Kumar, assisted by Sh. SP Goyal, counsel for petitioner.
Ms Navneet Bagga, Food Safety Officer, Food Safety Admn. GMSH: 16, Chandigarh.

Revision petitioner alongwith counsel has suffered the following statement:-

‘I have closed the food business in the premises in question i.e. Plot No. 193, Shashtri Nagar, New Shiv Mandir, Manimajra, Chandigarh. I will not do any food business in the premises. I will remove my machinery from the premises in question as soon as when the seal of the premises will be de-sealed by the competent authority. I will vacate the premises after removing my machinery on the same day.’

Ms. Navneet Bagga, Food Safety Officer, Food Safety Administration, GMSH-16, Chandigarh has also suffered the following statement:-

‘The premises in question was sealed as per the orders of the Sub Divisional Magistrate, East, U.T., Chandigarh as the petitioner was conducting food business without obtaining any requisite food license from the department. The food safety department, U.T., Chandigarh has no objection in de-sealing the premises in case the petitioner will remove the machinery and will not do any kind of food business except taking requisite license from the food department. The petitioner will not use the machinery after removing the same from the premises in question illegally.’

In view of the abovesaid statement, the SDM is directed to de-seal the premises so that the revision petitioner may vacate the premises after removing his machinery.

Adjourned to 29.09.2025 for awaiting status report.
