

Amit Vs. Sanjeev

Present: Sh. Gaurav Sharma, Advocate for the complainant.

Warrant of arrest issued against accused received back unexecuted with the report that he has gone out of station.

At this stage, learned counsel for complainant submitted that the accused is intentionally avoiding the process of Court. Neither has he repaid the amount due, and the cheque issued by him in the discharge of said liability has already been dishonoured, nor is he turning up in the present matter. Accordingly, proclamation proceeding against accused be initiated.

Heard. A careful perusal of case file shows that the present complaint was instituted in 2025 and bailable and non-bailable against accused has already been issued, but all in vain. Keeping in view the attending facts and circumstances, it appears that the accused is avoiding the process of law intentionally. This Court is satisfied that the presence of accused cannot be secured through ordinary process. Hence, let the presence of accused be secured through proclamation for **19.08.2026**. Executing official is directed to come present in the Court to get the statement recorded on **04.07.2026**. The proclamation shall be published on as follows:-

- (a) It shall be publically read in some conspicuous place on the town or village in which the accused resides.
- (b) It shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the house or homestead in which accused ordinary resides or in some conspicuous place of such town or village.
- (c) A copy thereof be affixed to some conspicuous part of the Court house.
