Today is fixed for payment and hearing.

Both parties file separate haziras.

Respondent/wife files a petition praying for vacating the stay order passed by this Court on 13.02.2026.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the respondent and submits that this court directed the appellant to pay Rs. 1 lakh today considering the due arrear of Rs. 2,10,000/- which is lying due till date but till date no payment has been made by the appellant. Ld. Advocate further submits that appellant violated the order of This Court passed on 13.02.2026 of conditional stay order on condition to pay Rs. 14,000/- per month to the respondent/wife and no payment has yet been made.

Heard. Considered.

Perused the said petition.

On perusal of the order no. 01 dated 13.02.2026 it appears that this Court has been pleased to stay the order dated 09.12.2025 passed by the Trial Court till the disposal of Criminal Appeal on condition that petitioner shall go on of Rs.14,000/- per month to the Respondent No.1/wife within 10th day of each succeeding month of English calender. An opportunity was also given to the appellant to pay Rs. 1 lakh today to the respondent/wife considering the due arrear. But till date no payment has been made by the appellant.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, the petition filed by the respondent/wife is allowed.

Let the stay order passed by this Court on 13.02.2206 is stands vacated.

Respondent is at libery to file execution against the appellant for realizing the interim maintenance amount.

Fix 04.08.2026 for payment and hearing.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Ld. Trial Court for information.
