

Criminal Misc. Case No. 203 of 2026

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioner namely; **Nayan Modak**, praying for anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest, in connection with Hura, P.S Case No. 32 of 2026 dated 20.02.2025 under Section 303(2)/317(2)/317(5)/61(2) of BNS and 21(1)(4) Mines & Minerals (R & D) Act, 1957, vide G.R. Case No. 319 of 2026.

Heard the bail prayer made by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High court, Calcutta.

Perused the CD and other materials on record.

Heard the Ld. P.P. who raises objection.

Having heard the submissions of the Ld. P.P as well as Ld. Defence counsel and having consulting with the case record as well as the materials on the case diary, it appears that the stolen sand has already been recovered and seized under the seizure list dated 20.02.2026 and the custodial interrogation for the purpose of investigation is not required in the present police case. Considering the entire scenario, I am inclined to allow the anticipatory bail prayer of the present accused person.

In the event of arrest, the accused petitioner be released, on furnishing bond of Rs.3000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 1500/- each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on compliance with the conditions as envisaged u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of. Return the C.D.
