

Criminal Misc. Case No. 204 2026

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioner namely; **1. Hriday Bauri and 2. Namita Bauri**, praying for anticipatory bail apprehending their arrest, in connection with Para, P.S Case No. 195 of 2025 dated 08.12.2025 under Section 85/80(2)/3(5) of BNS, vide G.R. Case No. 890 of 2025.

Heard the bail prayer made by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High court, Calcutta.

Perused the CD and other materials on record.

Heard the Ld. P.P. who raises objection.

Having heard the submissions of the Ld. P.P as well as Ld. Defence counsel and having consulting with the case record as well as the materials on the case diary, this is apparent that the charge sheet has already been submitted against the applicant/accused and there is no prayer on behalf of the prosecution for the custodial trial of the applicants/accused. The case record also reflects that the principal accused has already been enlarged on bail during the course of investigation. At this juncture, I find that the custodial interrogation of the applicants/accused for the purpose of investigation is not required. In such circumstances, the anticipatory bail prayer of the applicants/accused is hereby allowed.

In the event of arrest, the accused petitioners be released, on furnishing bond of Rs.6000/- each with two registered sureties of Rs. 3000/- each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on compliance with the conditions as envisaged u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of. Return the C.D.
